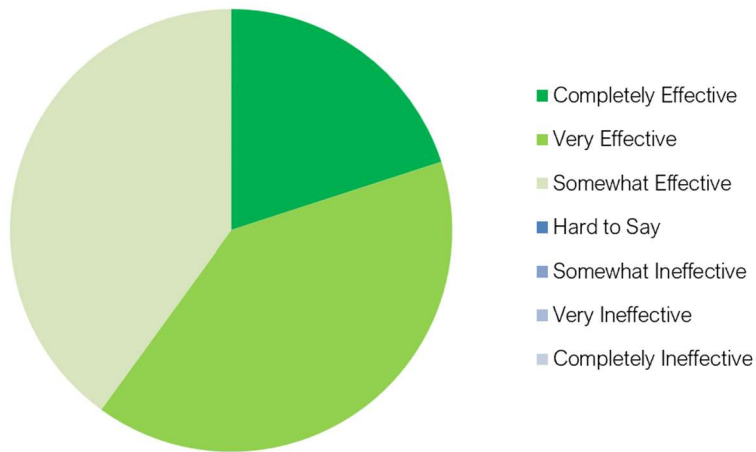

Effectiveness of Treatment and Care

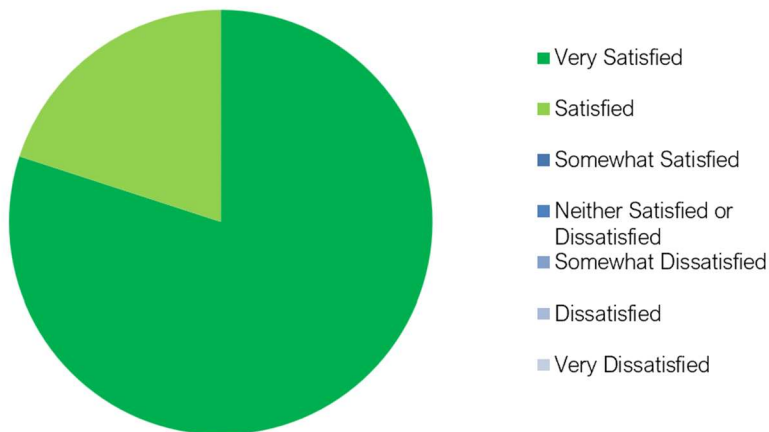


100% of patients have found their treatment and care effective.

0% of patients have found their treatment and care ineffective.

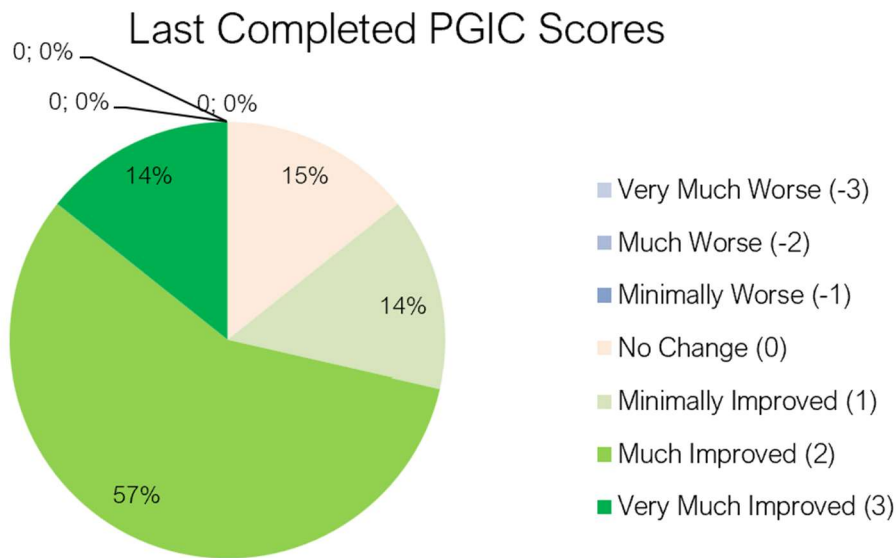
Quality of Treatment and Care

The above chart uses the most recent completed score of each patient in this report. This could be anything from 2 weeks to 1 year post plan initiation.

PGIC scores stand for **Patient Global Impression of Change**. It is a retrospective, self-reported scale that allows patients to evaluate how much their specific health conditions have improved or worsened since they started treatment.

Note: A positive PGIC score indicates improved health, with zero implying there is no change, and negative numbers indicating deteriorating health

Note: This report reflects all patient responses collected up to **20 May 2026**. Missing data from patients who did not complete follow-ups are excluded, which introduces a potential selection bias to the overall findings.
